

Safer Business Network's Safer Business Day of Action (SaBA) took place on the 13th March 2024.

The day of action was a multiagency approach to safety across the town centre.

The team included Stratford Original Ambassador Michael, Met Police Officers, Crime Progression Unit Officers, security personnel and the Safer Business Network team.

The day resulted in 6 Stop and Search, 9 arrests and 4 Community Resolutions.

Newham Council is supporting businesses and organisations across the borough to use cargo bikes for deliveries of goods and services through the Newham Cargo Bikes for Business scheme. The scheme offers free advice and one-off subsidies to help your business switch to either utilise a third-party cargo bike delivery service or to put towards the purchase of your own cargo bike. The subsidy for the purchase of a cargo bike is up to £1,500.

Newham Cargo Bikes for Business subsidies are available to any business, charity, stallholder, or organisation based in the Stratford Original BID area.

The scheme is running until August 2024. You can apply now for either:

- Up to £1500 towards purchasing or leasing a cargo bike
- 50 per cent off the cost of

using a cargo bike service (up to £300)

AMERICAN EXPRESS LAUNCHES GRANT PRO-GRAMME FOR SMALL RESTAURANTS IN LONDON

American Express is running its international grant scheme for independent restaurants for a third year. Restaurants, cafes, pubs across Greater London are invited to apply. A total of 20 eligible restaurants of community significance across both Manchester and London will each receive a grant of £11,000 to enhance their business operations and the experience for diners in the months ahead. The grant program is focused on venues owned or operated by under-represented or economically vulnerable members of the community.
