Dear Stratford Members,

I am sure you are all fully aware of the recent measures introduced by central Government to limit the spread of the virus. Whilst we all recognise the importance of public health, I know **Stratford businesses have worked hard and invested significant amounts of money to ensure shops and venues are COVID-secure.**

However, the **recent introduction of a 10PM curfew** has placed greater burdens on the hospitality industry, an already heavily regulated and struggling sector with very little evidence that this will slow the spread of the virus down.

Instead of introducing further restrictions, the focus should be on supporting businesses to comply and operate safely and provide sector specific support.

The Mayor of London has recently stated that "there can be no national recovery without a London recovery" and is calling for an **urgent new package of financial support** for the retail, hospitality, leisure and cultural sectors which play such a crucial role in Stratford's local economy.

As your BID, we also believe **London and Stratford businesses need additional support** and less burdens whilst we are all doing our bit to protect our families, colleagues and employees as well as creating tax revenues, jobs and opportunities for everyone. For these reasons, we will continue to work for you.

JOB RETENTION SCHEME

From the 1st October, you will need to pay 20% of your furloughed employees salaries, while the Government will pay 60% of usual wages up to a cap of £1,875 for the hours the employee does not work.
