Over the Summer we have commissioned specialist company Community Clean to deliver additional bespoke cleaning to our pavements. Hope you can see the difference that made!


Don't forget we are still offering our free training courses, discounted commercial waste rates, our friendly Ambassador Michael is still around to support you and much more.

You may remember us talk previously about our Business Crime Reduction Partnership (BCRP), something that we have been working extremely hard to implement as part of our ongoing efforts to make Stratford a safer place. It's been a long journey to this point and we are excited to announce that the partnership is now LIVE!

WHAT IS THE BUSINESS CRIME REDUCTION PARTNERSHIP?

This is a **joint partnership** and one of the key initiatives **supporting our Safer Stratford pillar.** Police data tells us that there are pockets of crime happening across Stratford, which in turn can have a negative impact on consumer and business confidence. As a result, **we wanted to introduce an initiative that makes it easier for businesses to report crime, work collaboratively with the police and ultimately make Stratford a desirable destination for consumers and businesses alike.** Our members now have access to a secure and GDPR compliant intelligence platform, that enables businesses to share and report intel. It's easy to use and extremely effective.

HOW CAN YOU GET INVOLVED?

To become an active member within the scheme, you can contact our BCRP Manager – Alessandra Valencic. Having worked at the Safer Business Network (SBN) for many years now, Alessandra is passionate about reducing crime rates and acting on behalf of local communities. She is responsible for co-ordingating several BCRPs, inlcuding an award winning one, so it's an absolute privilege to have her on board and working with us. WHAT WILL IT ACHIEVE?

The positive outcomes from this initiative are endless but it is reliant on businesses coming together and actively taking part. Here are some of the benefits for businesses that want to work with us to build a more confident community:

- Bespoke training delivered by SBN to upskill staff when dealing with incidents and increase confidence in staff reporting crime.
- Increased number of reports to the police related to business crime so that specific offender case files can start to form.
- A multi-agency approach means that we can start to tackle other issues such as drug taking and people sleeping rough.

FIRST MILE

All Stratford Original businesses have a new annual allocation of free Stratford Original Mixed Recycling Sacks, Cardboard Recycling Stickers or Glass Recycling Sacks ready to order from First Mile!

Stratford Original businesses are able to order free First Mile recycling sacks every year. Businesses receive a number of free sacks or stickers, based on business size, that reset on the 1st of April every year.

Stratford Original members also receive discounts on all of First Mile's recycling services, including Food Recycling, Coffee Grounds Recycling, Confidential Waste Recycling and over 20 other recycling streams.

To order your free recycling sacks or stickers or to sign up to the recycling scheme, contact First Mile's Customer Success Team on 0333 300 3448. If you haven't used the services for 12 months you will need to reactivate your account so that collection takes place or new bags can be delivered.
