We are backing the #BUSINESSSOS campaign, alongside other BID's across the UK. Calling on the Government to deliver support to our retail, hospitality and leisure businesses so they have every chance to survive following the rise in energy costs.

The three-point-plan:

Reduce VAT

- Headline rate reduced from 20% to 12.5%
- Business energy bills reduced from 20% to 5% to match domestic billing

• 100% rate relief until 31st March 2023

· A discounted kwh price on all business energy bills





STAFF SAFETY SURVEY RESULTS

The BCRP conducted surveys of over 120 local businesses to understand if and where staff don't feel safe or feel vulnerable. We have had real success in displaying these results to the local authorities by highlighting the key areas which need attention and suggesting solutions such as more lighting and CCTV cameras in those areas.

On top of this, phone boxes on the Broadway have been highlighted as a crime generator and an attraction for ASB and by working together with Newham Council and the police we managed to remove the phone boxes and replace them with new BT Screens, delivering a cleaner and more attractive town centre for customers and visitors, removing a crime facilitator from the area.

SAFER STRATFORD NIGHTS

Safer Stratford BCRP expanded their operations by starting 'Safer Stratford Nights' which is a monthly meeting for the nighttime economy members like pubs, bars, restaurants, hotels etc. to speak to their local policing team, licensing officers from both Council and Police and discuss offenders and relevant issues affecting their trading. This enabled a stronger connection and more communication to show effective partnership work and willingness to listen to venues' concerns, while promoting crime reporting.
