If your business is registered for VAT you must follow the Making Tax Digital rules.

This means you must keep your VAT records digitally and submit your VAT returns to HMRC using compatible software.

#### SAFER STRATFORD BCRP UPDATE

Safer Stratford BCRP continue to tackle crime and anti-social behaviour by growing in numbers with a total of 56 businesses as part of the scheme. Businesses are asked to share intelligence and incidents happening within their premises; this allowed us to issue a total of 7 Exclusion Notices to prolific offenders, 1 of which has been escalated by the court to a Criminal Behaviour Order thanks to MPS work.

Our Security intelligence meetings occur every other week in Stratford Mall; it was first initiated for the mall security team however now we have opened the forum to all security officers working in the mall and Broadway. Discussion on most prolific and recent offenders, crime trends and local issues along with the local policing team. The briefings are very well received and we are pleased to have been given the opportunity for businesses and police to discuss what matters the most to them.

We have continued our monthly joint patrols to address the look and feel of the town Centre, more hot spots areas are getting reported to the outreach team and cleansing team. We are in the process of setting up a follow up meeting after the patrol to track actions, results and keep monitoring the area.

#### NATIONAL INSURANCE INCREASE REVERSED

- April's National Insurance increase to be reversed from November
- Health and Social Care Levy will be cancelled -Chancellor has confirmed funding for health and social care services will be protected and will remain at the same level as if the Levy were in place
- Almost 28 million people will keep an extra £330 of their money on average next year, whilst 920,000 businesses are set to save almost £10,000 on average next year thanks to the change
