Average daily visitors by quarter and year





Our latest report from our data provider Huq shows the daily visitors by quarter across 2022, 2023 and 2024.

We can see that the average daily visitors are above the numbers we saw in 2022, however there is an overall fall in daily visitors across the year to date. While this trend follows the national and London-wide data, we can see a steeper decline. The numbers of average daily visitors for Q3 in Stratford is just below 80,000, compared to 75,000 in Q3 2022 and 115,000 in the same period for 2023. We can also see from the first graph that London continues to trend above the national average for footfall in 2024.


There are a number of factors that could explain this trend, including the cost of living crisis that has set challenges on people's disposable income. We can see from the graph on the right that the spending power of those visiting Stratford does not follow the London or National trend. The highest proportion of visitors (74%) have the spending power between £15,000-£20,000, this is a much higher proportion than the London and

National averages. Approximately 5% have spending power of £45,000.

We can see that Stratford sees an even distribution of visitors across the week, with Saturday being the highest at approximately 110,000 daily visitors. We can see that Mondays, Tuesdays, Fridays and Sundays are higher than daily visitors in 2023.

The largest number of visitors to Stratford by age are 30-44 year olds making up 33% of visitors, followed by 15-29 year olds at approximately 28% of visitors.

In our upcoming report we will be able to compare the footfall in Q4 and changes to the trend as we look ahead to 2025.




